

Using your vision benefits at Walmart and Sam's Club

Great news! Walmart Supercenters and Sam's Club locations across the U.S. complement DeltaVision's Insight and Access networks.^{1,2}

Prior to using your benefits at Walmart or Sam's Club, here are helpful tips to keep in mind:

► **Verify that both the provider and location are in-network.**

Call the Walmart or Sam's Club Vision Center to verify that an eye doctor works at that location, and to confirm the doctor is in-network for your vision plan. Some locations do not offer eye exams. Some doctors and the services they provide (like eye exams) are out-of-network, even when materials (like frames and lenses) from the same location are in-network. You may also choose to visit other providers and locations to maximize your benefits.

► **If the eye doctor is out-of-network, you'll need to submit the claim for reimbursement.**

If out-of-network benefits are applied, the doctor will charge you the full cost of the service, and you will need to submit a claim form for reimbursement. You may find this form on the DeltaVision member portal and submit it electronically through the portal or by mail. Detailed instructions are included on the form.

► **Additional discounts will not apply**

Due to Walmart and Sam's Club everyday low prices, extra discounts such as 40% off additional complete pairs of glasses, 20% off any remaining balance over the frame allowance, and 20% off items not covered under your benefits, will not apply.

¹Delta Dental of Arizona has partnered with EyeMed Vision Care to allow in-network coverage at Walmart and Sam's Club locations for DeltaVision group plan members whose plan leverages EyeMed's Insight or Access networks. Walmart and Sam's Club is out-of-network for individual plan members with a DeltaVision plan. Vision discount plans are also excluded.

²In-network benefits for materials, like frames, lenses and contact lenses, will apply at all Walmart and Sam's Club locations. Some Walmart and Sam's Club locations do not have a contracted doctor of optometry on-site, or the on-site doctor may be out-of-network for your plan. When this occurs, the services they provide (like eye exams) are out-of-network, even when materials from the same location are in-network.
