
NEW FACES, SAME MISSION

Reminder: Special Health Care Needs Benefit

When treating patients with special health care needs, please include both the narrative (including the special health need condition of the patient) and code D9997 (dental case management: patient with special health care needs).

We often receive one without the other, which delays processing. Submitting both together helps your patients receive their benefit and ensures your office is paid on time.

CLAIMS REMINDER: ADD PRIMARY PAYMENT DATA

Please include the primary payment amount in your electronic claim data, even when attaching the EOB via NEA#. This ensures accurate and timely claim processing.



Multi-factor authentication will be required starting October 20, 2025.

Protect your practice and patient data with multi-factor authentication. On October 20, 2025, all Dental Office Toolkit (DOT) and PACT users will need their password and an additional way to confirm their identity to log in to their Delta Dental DOT and PACT accounts.

What you need to do:

- Enroll in MFA immediately to protect your practice and patient data with an extra layer of security.
- Ensure each user has a unique sign-in (no shared accounts).
- Share this information with all team members who have Delta Dental provider accounts.

STILL FAXING YOUR CLAIMS?

There's a faster, easier way! Submit them electronically through the Dental Office Toolkit (DOT). DOT automatically fills in your provider and patient info. lets you add attachments and sends claims directly to our system. Skip the fax—go digital and avoid errors, poor image quality and processing delays.
