Despite an increasingly competitive environment, we were able to enhance our member benefits, advance the company and serve our participating dentists better in 2016. Notable highlights include:

- We welcomed 167 new dentists to Delta Dental, increasing the size of our network by 5%.

DENTISTS CAN HELP FIGHT OPIOID EPIDEMIC

Prescription opioid abuse has been steadily rising over the years, with Arizonans among the hardest hit by the epidemic. According to a Cronkite News report, more than 2 million grams of oxycodone came into the state in 2015—putting Arizona at the third-highest total per capita in the country. And since 2010, more than 3,600 people have overdosed and died from opioids in Arizona.

Last fall, the American Dental Association issued a statement on the use of opioids in the treatment of dental pain. When considering prescribing opioids, the ADA advised dentists to:

- Conduct a medical and dental history to determine current medications, potential drug interactions and history of substance abuse
- Follow CDC and state licensing board recommendations for safe opioid prescribing
- Use a prescription drug monitoring program
- Teach patients about proper storage and disposal of medications and how to prevent misuse and abuse
- Consider nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory analgesics as the first-line therapy for acute pain management
- Recognize multimodal pain strategies for management for acute postoperative pain
- Seek continuing education in addictive disease and pain management


