2023 Grants Include Access to Nutrition Programs

Delta Dental of Arizona Foundation awarded grants to 33 non-profit organizations working to increase access to oral health services and provide nutritional programs for underserved populations across Arizona. \$743,536 was awarded to support projects and services increasing access to dental care and nutritional food among underserved children, pregnant women, seniors and - for the first time adults.

A New Leaf

A New Leaf is a nonprofit organization in Phoenix that provides programs to help families recover violence and abuse. The Healthy Smiles for Life program at A New Leaf provides dental hygiene education and supplies to adults and school-age children. In 2023, this program will impact



approximately 570 children and youth and 550 adults served by A New Leaf's after-school, homeless and family shelter, supportive and affordable housing, and early childhood education programs. DDAZ Foundation provided a \$20,000 grant to support this program in 2023 and \$10,000 in 2022. In addition, in 2022 the DDAZ associates voted to present A New Leaf with a \$5,000 surprise grant to commemorate DDAZ's 50th Anniversary.
